BUSINESS SKILLS PROGRAMME FOR CHILDCARE PROVIDERS

Limerick Childcare Committee in collaboration with Limerick Enterprise Office, are pleased to offer this tailor made Business Skills Programme for Owner/Mangers of childcare services, in both the private and community sector. Each of the 4 topic areas will be delivered as a stand-alone course, giving providers the option to select specific modules, depending on their needs. Participants can complete all 4 modules if they so wish. Venue and times are the same for all programmes.

TOPIC 1 FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT (2 × 3 hour sessions, plus 1 mentor site visit)

Mon 19th Oct & Mon Nov 2nd - 7.00pm to 9.00pm Tutor: Marie Cooney

• The objective is to strengthen areas of financial management i.e. enhance ability to plan and monitor cash flow, to work well with their accountant, utilising profit and loss statements and balance sheet and to plan for improvements in margin, cash flow management and longer term viability, to review Companies Registration Office requirements of company directors

Topics will include, introduction to accounting principles, primary books and routines, Profit and Loss and VIABILITY, cashflow planning and monitoring for the private and community

providers, maximising Accountant and Owner/Manager roles, compliance with Companies Office, taxation for self-employed

Participant has the opportunity to meet confidentially in the childcare facility with the tutor for 3 hours, to plan for implementation.

TOPIC 2 STAFF MOTIVATION & MANAGEMENT AND EMPLOYMENT LAW (2 × 3 hour sessions, plus 1 mentor site visit)

• The objective is to be able to put systems in place as an employer, to comply with employment law, and to be fully ready for a NERA audit, thereby recruiting wisely, and utilising policies and procedures to manage staff. Recognising the key role of motivated and competent staff to the childcare business, to provide practice sessions and feedback on how best to brief staff. One to one developmental feedback to re-enforce standards and to re-direct as required, to support staff to embrace change as a career strength and a vital component of business competitiveness

Topics will include preparing for a NERA audit identifying potential areas of exposure, practice sessions using work aids provided to recruit wisely, good interview questions, recording at the interview, giving supportive feedback to motivate and give direction, giving feedback to deal with non-conformance and conflict as it arises, re-direct behaviours and explain consequences. Communicating the need for change and seeking 100% commitment for implementation

Participant has the opportunity to meet confidentially in the childcare facility with the tutor for 3 hours, to plan for implementation.

TOPIC 3 MARKETING AND PROMOTION (2 x 3 hour sessions, plus 1 mentor site visit) Mon 23rd Nov & Mon 30th Nov - 7.00pm to 9.00pm Tutor: Niamh Keely

• The objective is to maximise marketing opportunities, including print, social media and networking, in order to maintain a vibrant presence in the market and bring in new business in a proactive way • Topics will include researching the market, communicating your promotional message, introduction to Online Marketing and Social Media and some risks using Facebook and a website to promote the business and to maintain communication with clients

Participant has the opportunity to meet confidentially in the childcare facility with the tutor for 3 hours, to plan for implementation.

TOPIC 4 OWNER MANAGER DEVELOPMENT (2 x 3 hour sessions, plus 1 mentor site visit)

• The objective is to assist the owner/manager to set realistic 12 month operational goals, and to review the most appropriate contribution to this; to improve management skills in their chosen area/s and hence enhance the running of the business

Topics will include Owner Manager roles, impact of personality differences, assertiveness and delegation, personal effectiveness, with a focus on prioritising time on key goals of the business Participant has the opportunity to meet confidentially in the childcare facility, with the tutor in a mentor capacity for 3 hours, to plan for implementation.
